Description

The proposed ProLogis Park 70 development is expected to contain approximately 2.9 million square feet of light industrial development. I-70 and E-470 are the major roadways serving the site. This development presented some unique challenges due to the fact that the existing E-470 and I-70 interchange is interim. The Colorado Department of Transportation and E-470 have not finalized the ultimate freeway-to-freeway design as well as when the improvements would be made. Therefore, the traffic impact analysis report had to analyze the effect of E-470 traffic on the existing ramp intersections. Specific trigger traffic volumes were established that would require improvements for selected intersections. Because the proposed development is expected to generate a large number of heavy truck trips, the traffic impact analysis report had to estimate truck percentages for each turn movement.
